

LCTA Negotiations Report 4-17-17

On April 17, 2017, the LCTA negotiations team met with representatives from the District from 9:00 am to 2:00 pm to continue discussion on extra duty extra pay and a salary increase. The District offered studies on each of these topics in anticipation of submitting a proposal at the next negotiations session. The District also proposed opening discussion on child bonding language, adding more late start days, and increasing incentives for teacher attendance with an aim to raise the daily substitute pay rate. Because contract articles concerning leaves were not sunshined for this year's negotiations, both teams agreed to table child bonding and other leaves language changes until next year. Likewise, sub pay rates fall outside the scope of LCTA contract negotiations. After identifying questions and further areas for study, the LCTA and District teams agreed to continue further discussion on potential changes to the late start calendar, extra duty/extra pay, and salary this Friday at 9:00. Teams also set additional negotiations dates for 5/4, 5/23, and 5/25.
